


Directions

From I-5

Take the Kent/DesMoines exit and head east into Kent. Turn left (north) onto Central Avenue and follow north for 1/2 mile. Turn right (east) on Smith Street and follow east to East Titus Street. Turn right (south) onto East Titus Street. Turn left (east) at Reiten Road. The park entrance is on the left (north).

From Kent

Drive west on Smith Street into the Kent valley. Turn left (south) at the intersection of Smith Street and east Titus Street. Turn left (east) at Reiten Road. The park entrance is on the left (north).
